Since 2008, he has been an Assistant Professor at the Department of Romance Languages at **Palacký University Olomouc (Czech Republic)**. He has published five books and over 50 journal articles and book chapters, primarily on **Spanish and Czech morphology and phraseology**. His recent research focuses on **Machine Translation reception**. He has supervised more than 100 BA and MA theses, three PhD theses, and, starting in September 2025, will supervise one MSCA postdoctoral researcher.
