Miroslav Vepřek Ph.D., is an Associate Professor at Palacký University Olomouc with research focused on

Diachronic Slavistics, especially on Old Church Slavonic, Old Czech, Etymology. His scholar methodology stems from basic philological research but also includes applications of new methods and approaches (frequency research, stylometric analyses, the grammaticalization theory). With his experience from international academic stays, conferences, invited lectures (such as University of Vienna or The Old Church Slavonic Institute in Zagreb), and cooperation with colleagues through Europe, dr. Vepřek has an extensive knowledge and network to offer.
