In 2024, he completed a HORIZON EUROPE internship at the University of Trier with Prof. Christopher Schoch, working on literary cartographic and quantitative models of Czech novels. He developed the digital corpus Korpus Prózy and its analytical tools. He has presented his research at international conferences, including in Italy, Spain, France, Portugal, and the USA.

- Knowledge especially in narratology, spatial studies, digital humanities.
- Basic knowledge of programming (e.g. Python)
- Knowledge of the Czech language on the level of at least B2 CEFR
- A clear idea of the concrete applicability and usefulness of the project output

Potential candidates need to have held a doctoral degree (Ph.D.) for **no longer than 8 years** and have **not resided in the Czech Republic for more than 12 months** during the **past 3 years**, at the time of the submission.
